### **IWK DENIES SUSPICION THAT THE COMPANY WAS THE CAUSE OF FIRE INCIDENTS IN KAMPUNG PANDAN**

**Kuala Lumpur:** Indah Water Konsortium (IWK) denies suspicion that the company had caused the fire incidents in Kampung Pandan, in relation to an article in Malaysian Nanban, entitled "Kampung Pandan Residents Live in Fear over Fire Incidents".

The suspicion is baseless as the incident has nothing to do with IWK's operations in the affected area.

However, IWK expresses its sympathy to the thirty families who were left homeless after the fire destroyed their houses.

According to the news article, the residents 'suspect this could be Indah Water Konsortium (IWK)'s technique to get the people out from the place,' which IWK denies. The article further quoted the residents that 'IWK has been claiming the land recently,' to which it is baseless as IWK does not own any land in Kampung Pandan.
